In The Shop and Garden Centre



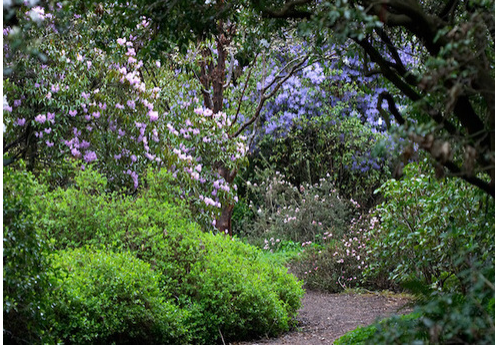
Seeds from the FOG Seed Collectors and Spring Perennials

Our Garden Centre is stocked with perennials, shrubs, and trees grown by our Friends of the Garden volunteers. Early bloomers like *Galanthus*, *Bergenia*, and *Pachyphragma macrophyllum* are available, all grown by the 'Back 40' group.
